

Our theme park is based on four pillars. These four areas require different **use guidelines**:

- The **Exhibition Area**: After paying the entrance fee, you will receive this guide and a helmet which you must put on as soon as you enter the Garnet Gallery.
- The **Garnet Gallery**: Please put on your helmet.
- The **Digging Grounds**: Here you will be handed protective goggles and a geologist's hammer. Any tools you have brought along with you must not be used! (**Protective goggles and helmets are obligatory!**) When you have finished digging, please return the protective goggles, the hammer and the helmet to the digging master!
- The **free-of-charge Outdoor Terrain**: Accessible up to the "Blauer Tumpf" without any particular equipment. Dogs are allowed into the free-of-charge open-air ground.

For the sake of your own safety, please follow the instructions given in this information leaflet, by the staff, or through the safety-related loudspeaker announcements.

**1.** The **Main Building** with the entrance and exit area: Here you will find the ticket booth, the shop and the gemstone grindery. On the first floor you will find the stunning Garnet Exhibition along with the Garnet Room that is currently under construction.

**2.** The **Garnet Gallery** with all its hidden secrets and the unique opportunity to access a garnet vein.

**3.** The **Digging Grounds** where you can dig garnet gemstones yourself and process them afterwards.

**4.** The **Outdoor Terrain** with wooden bridge, resting area, drinking-water fountain, a rope bridge and the vantage point "Blauer Tumpf".

For accessing the adjoined **ropeway**, you will need a guide. If you use it without a guide, you access it at your own risk!
